DETAILED ACTION

Notice of Pre-AIA or AIA Status

The present application, filed on or after March 16, 2013, is being examined under the first inventor to file provisions of the AIA.

Claims 1-44 are pending in the instant application. Claims 1-44 are allowed.

Response to Amendment and Arguments/Remarks

The amendment and arguments/remarks filed on April 16, 2024 have been fully considered and entered into the application. With regards to the 35 U.S.C. 112(b) rejection, 35 U.S.C. 112(d) rejection, 35 U.S.C. 102(a)(1) rejection as being anticipated by WO 2004/063156 A1, and the claim objection, the grounds for rejection and objection are moot in view of Applicant's amendment and the rejections and objection have been withdrawn.

REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE

The compounds of Formulae I, II and III or pharmaceutically acceptable salts or stereoisomers thereof, pharmaceutical compositions thereof and methods of using a compound of the instant claims are novel and non-obvious over the prior art because of the structural limitations of the compounds. The prior art does not disclose a compound which fits within the scope of those of the instant claims nor does it disclose an obvious variant. Therefore, the compounds of the prior art have different properties than those of the instant claims.
